What information we collect, use, and why

We collect or use the following information to **provide and improve products and services for clients**:

- Names and contact details
- Occupation
- Usage data (including information about how you interact with and use our website, products and services)
- Information relating to compliments or complaints
- Audio recordings (e.g. calls)
- Website user information

We collect or use the following personal information for the **operation of client or customer accounts**:

- Names and contact details
- Account information, including registration details
- Video recordings, website usage data, IP addresses

We collect or use the following personal information for **information updates or marketing purposes**:

- Names and contact details
- Profile information
- Marketing preferences
- Purchase or account history
- Website and app user journey information

We collect or use the following personal information for **recruitment purposes**:

- Contact details (e.g. name, address, telephone number or personal email address)
- Date of birth
- National Insurance number
- Employment history (e.g. job application, employment references or secondary employment)
- Education history (e.g. qualifications)

We collect or use the following personal information for **dealing with queries, complaints or claims**:

- Names and contact details

Lawful bases and data protection rights

Under UK data protection law, we must have a "lawful basis" for collecting and using your personal information. There is a list of possible lawful bases in the UK GDPR. You can find out more about lawful bases on the ICO's website.

Which lawful basis we rely on may affect your data protection rights which are in brief set out below. You can find out more about your data protection rights and the exemptions which may apply on the ICO's website:

- **Your right of access** – You have the right to ask us for copies of your personal information. You can request other information such as details about where we get personal information from and who we share personal information with. There are some exemptions which means you may not receive all the information you ask for. [You can read more about this right here.](#)
- **Your right to rectification** – You have the right to ask us to correct or delete personal information you think is inaccurate or incomplete. [You can read more about this right here.](#)

- **Your right to erasure** – You have the right to ask us to delete your personal information. [You can read more about this right here.](#)
- **Your right to restriction of processing** – You have the right to ask us to limit how we can use your personal information. [You can read more about this right here.](#)
